

**RESOLUTION NO. 00-09- 48**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 00-07-32; ADOPTING AN ADJUSTED PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, in Resolution No. 00-07-32 adopted on July 25, 2000, the City Council of the City of Marathon, Florida (the "City") determined a proposed millage rate; and

**WHEREAS**, the provisions of Section 200.065(2), Florida Statutes, require a municipality within eighty (80) days of certification of taxable value to re-compute the proposed millage rate; and


**WHEREAS**, the City Council has held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its proposed millage levy and to consider an operating budget for the period of October 1, 2000 to September 30, 2001 (the "Fiscal Year 2000/2001"), in accordance with the provisions of Section 200.065(2)(c), Florida Statutes.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. That the Fiscal Year 2000/2001 proposed millage rate on all taxable assessed property value as provided by Resolution No. 00-07-32 is hereby recomputed and tentatively established at 2.9645 mills, which is \$2.96 dollars for each thousand dollars of taxable assessed property value, for the tax year commencing from and after January 1, 2000.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
