

RESOLUTION NO. 01-05-27

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING PROPERTY FOR ACQUISITION BY THE MONROE COUNTY LAND AUTHORITY FOR RECREATIONAL USES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council of the City of Marathon, Florida (the “City”) to provide additional recreational land within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City had nominated property for acquisition by the Monroe County Land Authority (the “Land Authority”) for recreational uses through Resolution No. 00-11-72 dated November 8, 2000 (a copy of which is attached as Exhibit “A”); and

WHEREAS, the City supports the Land Authority in their efforts to re-designate the property located on U. S. 1 between 75th and 76th Streets in Marathon as a possible alternative future site for the City of Marathon Rotary Park; and

WHEREAS, the City hereby supports the Land Authority’s acquisition of either property for the future site of the City of Marathon Rotary Park.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The City Council shall assume all responsibilities for the property, including development and maintenance, once the desired site has been acquired by the Monroe County Land Authority.

Section 3. The City Manager and the City Attorney are authorized to finalize the terms and conditions of a lease Agreement, if necessary, with the Monroe County Land

Authority to this effect, and the Mayor is authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City.

Section 4. The City Council acknowledges that once the desire site is acquired by the Monroe County Land Authority, future use of said property will be limited to recreational uses and all revenue-generating activities will be prohibited.

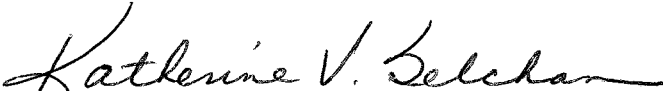
Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

RESOLUTION NO. 00-11-72

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, NOMINATING PROPERTY
FOR ACQUISITION BY THE MONROE COUNTY LAND
AUTHORITY FOR RECREATIONAL USES; AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council of the City Marathon, Florida (the "City") to provide additional recreational land within the City.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Recitals. The above recital is true and correct and is incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The City Council nominates Parcels A and B of Cianchette Commercial Subdivision (the "Parcels") for acquisition by the Monroe County Land Authority for the purpose of providing recreational land. The Parcels are more fully described as follows:

Parcels A and B of Cianchette Commercial Subdivision, Plat Book 7,
Page 56, less and except property deeded by warranty deed recorded in
Official Record Book 1390, Pages 522-525, of the Public Records of
Monroe County, Florida.

Section 3. The City Council shall assume all responsibilities for the Parcels, including development and maintenance, once the site has been acquired by the Monroe County Land Authority. The City Council is prepared to enter into a lease agreement with the Monroe County Land Authority to this effect, subject to review and approval of the lease agreement by the City Manager and City Attorney.

EXHIBIT "A"

Section 4. The City Council acknowledges that once the site is acquired by the Monroe County Land Authority, future use of the property will be limited to recreation and all revenue-generating activities will be prohibited.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
