**WHEREAS**, the City of Marathon is located within Monroe County and benefits from Billy Wagner's many years of experience in emergency management and hurricane preparedness.



Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.



Section 3.     Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.


